Liz gave a report on the District BAC meeting which occurred on Monday. The meeting's focus was on state testing. The problem being that by the time we get the data back from the state it is too late for it to be useful for preparing for the next test.

Doug Hesbol has new curriculum to look at by spring break. All three elementary schools in the district use different maths. There is no integration between the schools. Every Day Math is used at the middle school. Clubs and sports should also be integrated
