



Protocols for the 2021-2022 School Year:

Masks:

- All students must wear a mask while in the building
- Students will have to mask in PE unless it is taking place outdoors or during a mask break
- Preschool students are now required to wear masks while in the building
- All staff (vaccinated or not) must wear a mask in the building
- All visitors must wear a mask, while in the building, and only have access to the office

On Site Testing:

- Unvaccinated staff will be tested twice a week
- All vaccinated staff can voluntarily test weekly
- Students will be tested with parent permission
- Testing will begin the week of 9/13

Assemblies and Volunteering:

- Assemblies are suspended until further notice
- Volunteering in the building is suspended until further notice
- Both of these will be reviewed as the year progresses
- Assemblies and volunteering are top priorities and will be reenacted as soon as possible
- In person gatherings and events are on hold at this time due to recent concerns and county mandates.

COVID Quarantines, Testing, and Communication:

- Quarantines, testing and communication to the community is decided by the county
- Personal medical information of students and staff can not be shared with the public
- Individuals that have had direct exposure will be notified as directed by the county
- GCS must follow all county mandates and protocols
