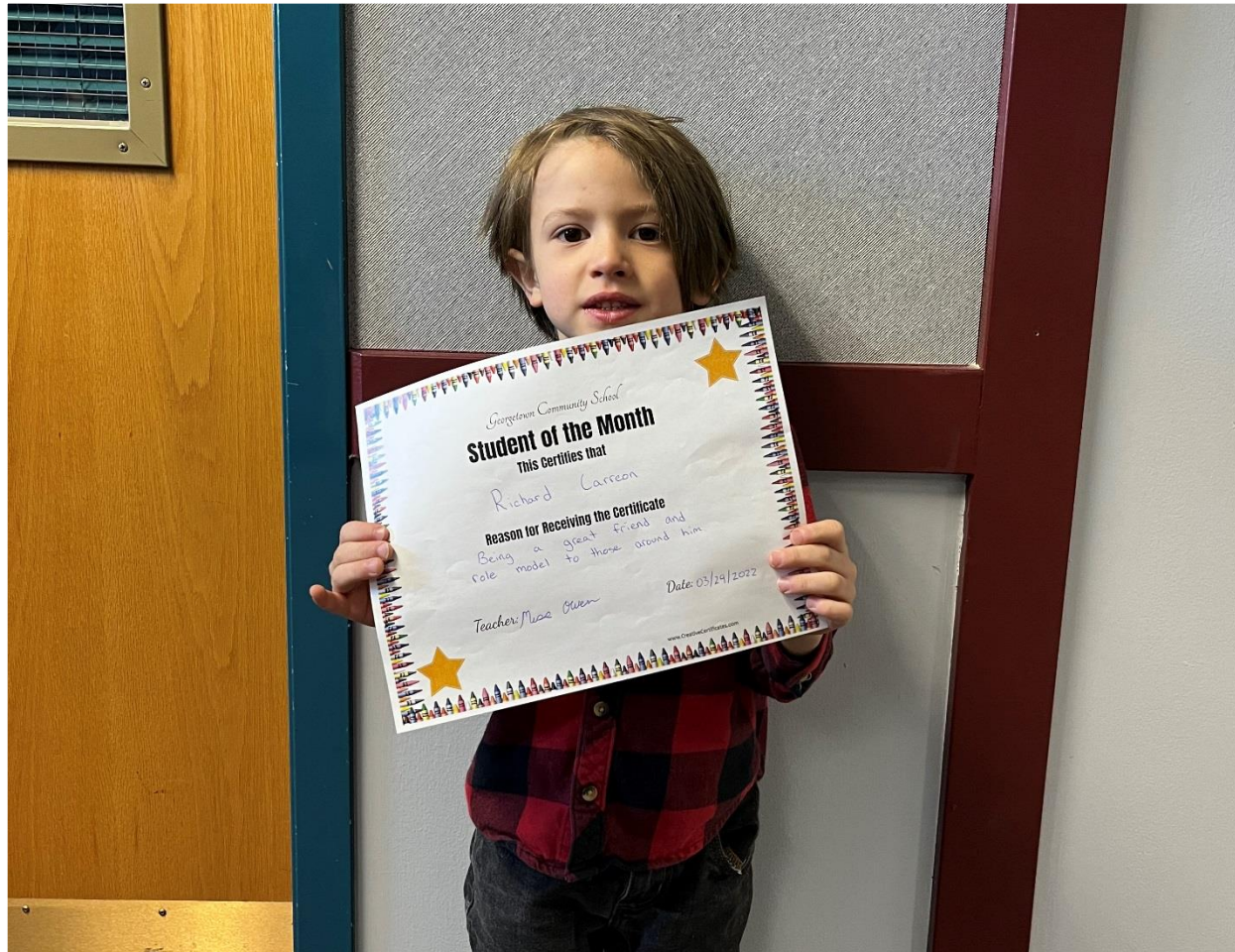

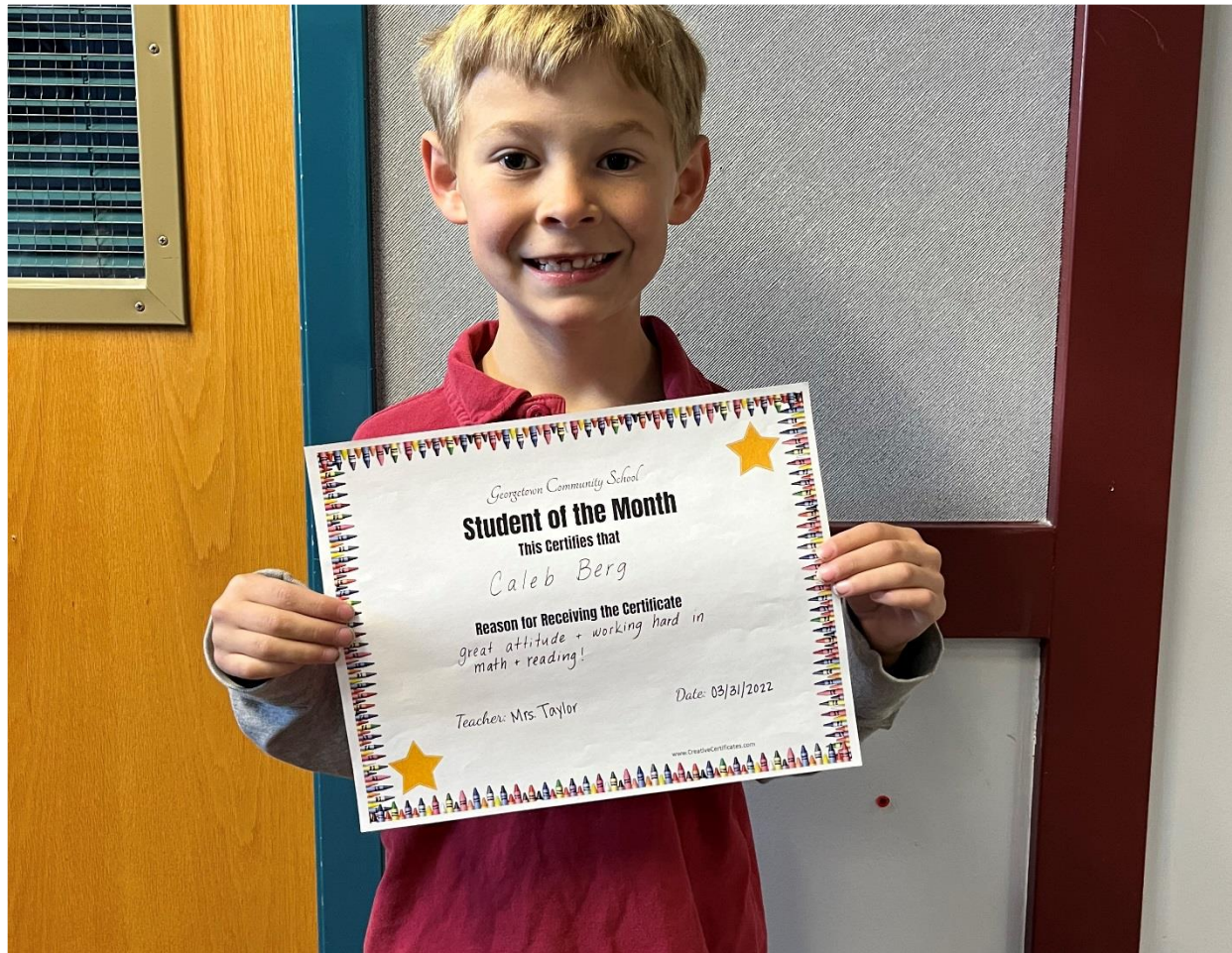

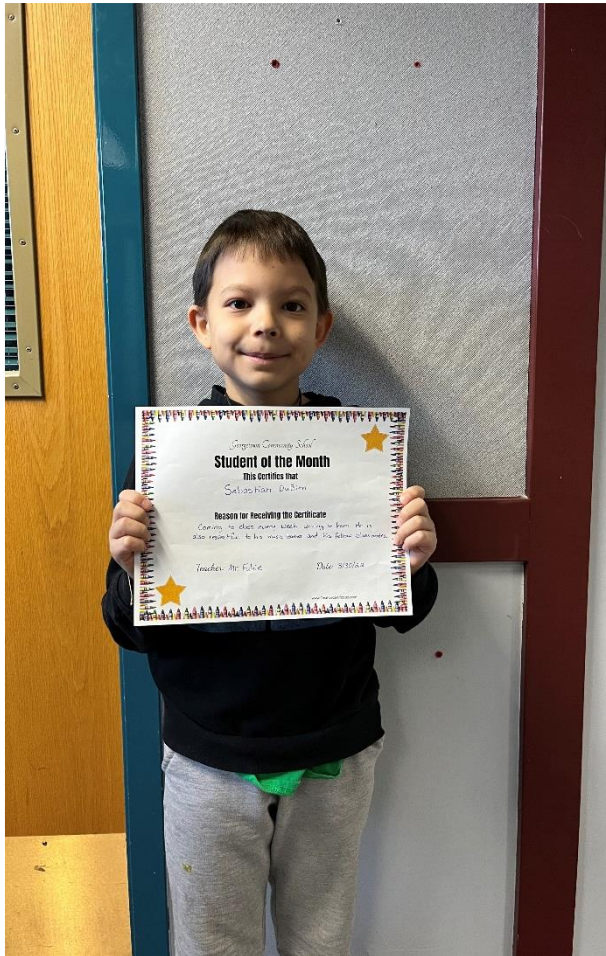




# Music

# Physical Education

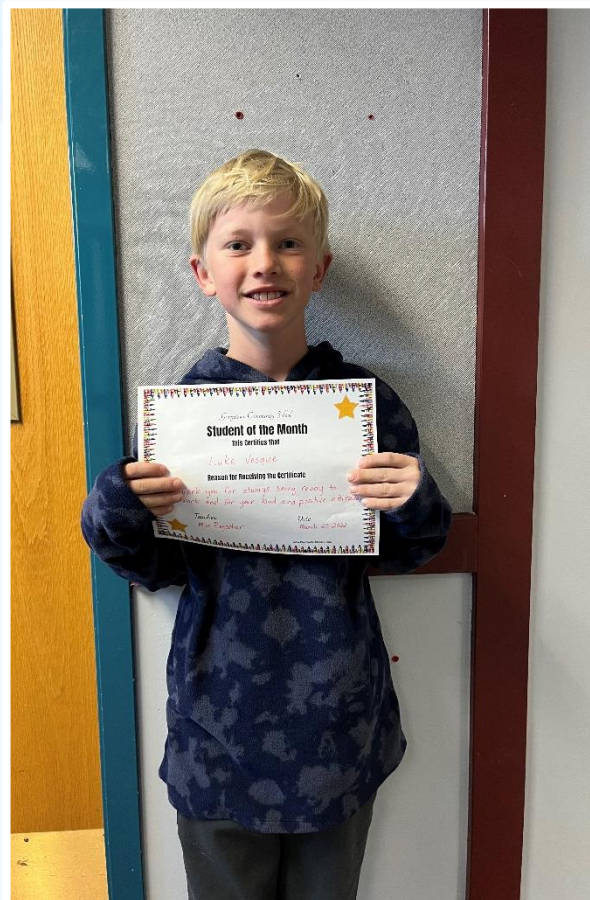
